After his PhD in Public law specialized in Constitutional law at Montpellier University School of Law and his degree at Fulbright Scholar, Harvard University School of Law he came back in Palestine where he is lawyer and Constitutional law Professor. In 1992 he established the first law school in Palestine and was Dean in Al Quds University until 2002. From 2001 to 2003 he was the General Secretary of the Palestinian Constitution Committee. From 2005 to 2007 he was Consultant - Arkan Project to supporting the legal education and the rule of law in Palestine. He was Minister of Justice of Palestinian National Authority from 2007 to 2012 and Member of Venice Commission -the European Commission for Democracy through Law Council of Europe from 2008 to 2017. As Author of several academic Publications on constitutional law, he dedicates a relevant part of his research in the field of the Rights of Women in the Palestinian Basic Law and Islam. Professor of Constitutional law in several international Universities (Al Quds University in Jerusalem, Birzeit University in Ramallah, Istanbul Şehir Unieversitesi in Istanbul, Università eCampus in Italy), now he is the President of Global Center for Justice and Humanity.
