After graduating from Konya İmam-Hatip High School and Selçuk University Faculty of Theology, she obtained her master's degree in 1998 with her dissertation entitled "Rasûlullah'ın Hanımları Konu Alan Rivayetlerinin Değerlendirmesi-Kadın Konulu Uydurma Rivayetler" and her PhD degree in 2005, with her thesis entitled "Birgili Mehmed Efendi'nin Hadisçiliği ve et-Tarîkatü'l-Muhammediyye (Tahkik ve Tahlil)" at the same university. Between the years 1999-2000, she received training at Şuayb el-Arnaûd Tahkik (inquiry) and Tahric Centre in Amman, the capital of Jordan. She became an Assistant Professor in 2011, Associate Professor in 2012 and Professor in 2017. She worked as editor and author in the Topical Hadith Project of the Directorate of Religious Affairs which was published with the name Hadislerle İslam. She was appointed as the Head of the Department of Family and Religious Guidance of the Directorate of Religious Affairs in 2011, the Counselor of the Directorate of Religious Affairs in 2014 and Vice President of the Directorate of Religious Affairs in 2017. She authored articles, attended conferences and published papers tackling the themes of woman, family, morals and values from the perspective of religious tradition.
