Dr. Medaim Yanık, completed his degree at Istanbul Faculty of Medicine and his specialization on psychiatry at Cerrahpasa Medical Faculty. In 2005 he became an assistant professor in the field of Mental Health and Diseases. Between the years 2005 and 2009, he served as head physician and clinic chief in Bakırköy Prof. Dr. Mazhar Osman Mental Health and Psychiatry Hospital. In this period, he led the transition process of electroconvulsive therapy with anesthesia and neuromuscular blocker. At the same time he was consultant at Ministry of Health on mental health. He studied in the fields of "Writing a mental action plan", "Transition to a community mental health", "Improvement of psychiatric hospitals", "Architecture of psychiatric hospitals". From 2009 to 2015, he worked as founding assistant professor at the department of psychiatry at Istanbul Sehir University. He was entitled as professor in 2010. In 2017 he began to give lectures at the Department of Psychology at İbni Haldun University. Also he works at his private clinic. He wrote his Ph. D thesis on childhood traumatic experiences and dissociative disorders. In his work, he interrogates the relationship between forgetting and recalling physical, emotional and sexual traumas in childhood and dissociative symptoms. The psychotherapy of patients with dissociative identity impairment is one of the areas that he is specialized. He also wrote a book titled "Divided Minds: Diagnosis and Treatment of Dissociative Identity Disorder". Additionally, he studies "family and spousal relations". He has books titled "Dest-i İzdivaç: Kim Kiminle Evlenirse Mutlu Olur?", "Mutlu Evliliklerin 7 Özelliği". He has also developed a "Program for Empowerment of Marriage".
